LXDE

Lightweight X11 Desktop Environment

- less resource hungry, lighter, faster
- LX: also Linux
- especially designed for new generation devices like netbooks and MIDs.
- Written in C
- Started by PCMan from Taiwan in 2005

LXDE

Lightweight X11 Desktop Environment

- takes 4.6 M on a normal Fedora install with base and base-x. Xfce for example takes 22,8 M, Gnome 177 M.
- optimized for low memory usage.
- follows a modular approach, so you can easily add/remove/replace components. All applications support different configuration profiles to work in different desktop environments.

LXDE

Lightweight X11 Desktop Environment

- Due to its modular approach there are no long dependency chains. Most packages only require gtk2.
- Supports input methods and accessibility because it uses gtk.
- has everything a desktop needs: Panel with plugins, desktop with icons, session manager, task manager, text editor, image viewer, archive manager.

- **LXNM** (still under development): Lightweight network connection helper daemon for LXDE supporting wireless connections (Linux-only)
- **LXDE Common**, the default settings configuration file for integrating the different components of LXDE. LXDE Common manages the system behavior and functions to integrate icons and artwork.
- **GtkNetCat**, Graphic User Interface for netcat. Netcat provides system functions as a computer networking utility for reading from and writing to network connections on either TCP or UDP.

LXDE is compatible

- thus applications running on Gnome distributions e.g. of Debian or Ubuntu, can be installed with LXDE.

LXDE, *Lightweight X11 Desktop Environment*, is a desktop environment which is lightweight and fast. It is designed to be user friendly and slim, and keep the resource usage low. LXDE uses less RAM and less CPU while being a feature rich operating system. Because of the low usage of resources it also saves energy. We don't tightly integrate every component of LXDE. Instead, we try to make all components independent, so each of them can be used independently with few dependencies. This makes porting LXDE to different distributions and Unix systems easier. A good starting point is the [General Information](#) page, where you find information on system requirements and compatibility. You also find an overview of [distributions including LXDE with installation instructions](#), information on [LXDE components](#) and our future plans on the wiki. More about LXDE on the [lxde.org website](#), the [LXDE blogs](#), and in the [LXDE forum](#).

- **PCManFM**, is a fast and lightweight file manager with features like Drag & Drop support, tabbed browsing (Similar to Firefox), Built-in file searching utility, fast load of large directories, File association support (Default application), Thumbnail for image files, Bookmarks support, correct handling of non-UTF-8 encoded filenames and more
- **LXLauncher**, easy-mode application launcher
- **LXPanel**, desktop panel, The panel can generate menu for installed applications automatically from *.desktop files. It can be configured from GUI preference dialog, and there is no need to edit config files. The component provides a "Run" dialog with autocompletion.

“*The Association's purpose is the promotion and distribution of free desktop software in terms of free software, and the program package 'Lightweight X11 Desktop Environment, LXDE' in particular, to promote the free exchange of knowledge and equality of opportunity in accessing software as well as education, science and research.”*
(Oct. 24, 2008, Articles of LXDE Foundation)

The LXDE Foundation supports the development of LXDE by distributing the desktop environment and by securing funding and hardware. The LXDE Foundation e.V. is a non-profit legal entity representing the LXDE Project. In October 2008 the LXDE Foundation e.V. was registered as an association under German law. The "e.V." stands for "eingetragener Verein" which means "registered non-profit association".




LXDE is an extremely faster and more energy saving desktop environment. It was started by Hong Jen Yee in 2005 with the development of the first component PCMan File Manager. Soon an international community joined development. On October 24, 2008 a group of contributors, supporters and developers met at the c-base in Berlin to found the LXDE Foundation. Members of the foundation currently include contributors from Taiwan, Germany, France, Spain, the US, China, Turkey, Korea, Afghanistan, Uganda, Ghana, Poland, India, Greece and Italy.

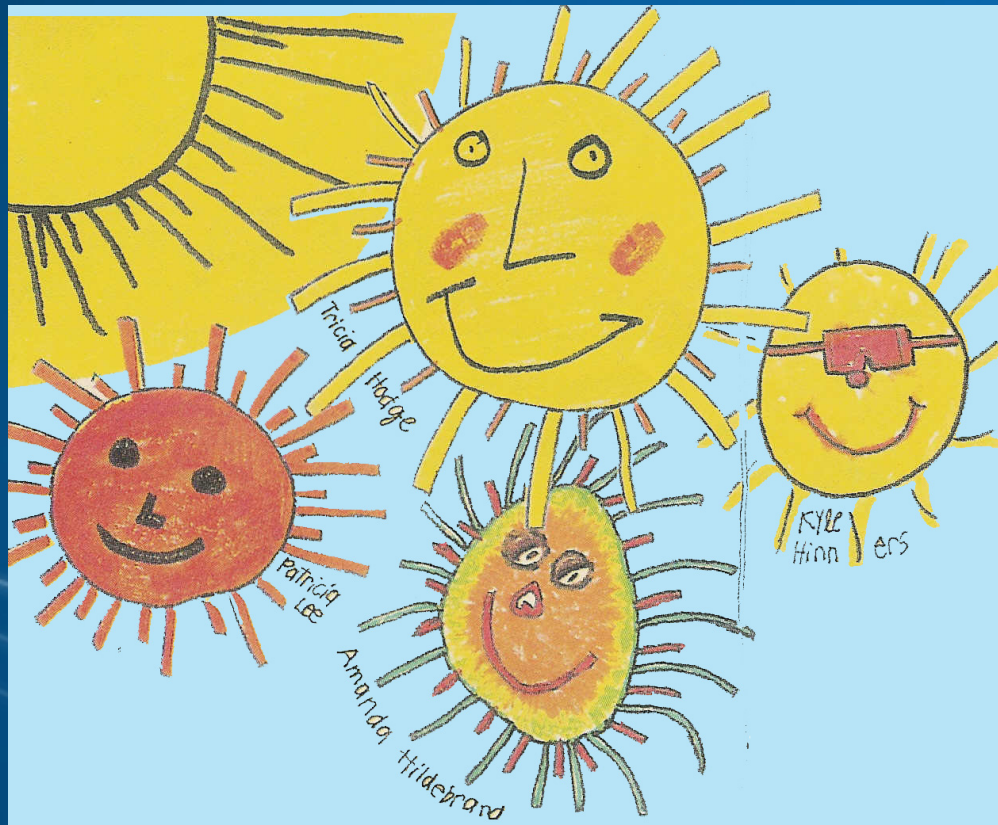
